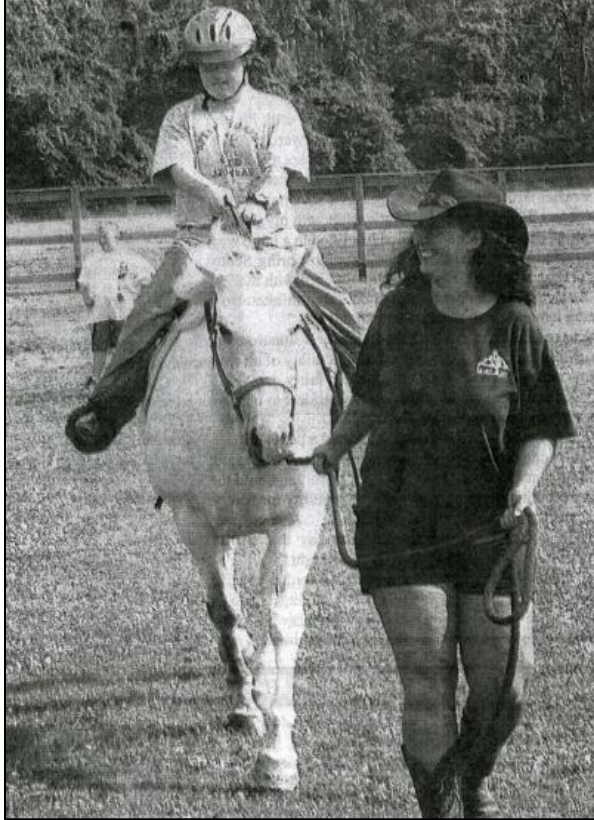


A Spirit'ed Ride
